

# By Proclamation of the King of France

On this day, January 15 1672 AD, I King Louis XIV, hereby  
appoint Louis de Buade, Count Frontenac, as the Governor of  
New France.

By serving in this capacity, his duties are to represent the interests of France and to obey all  
laws as by order of the King.

With his acceptance the Governor will be responsible for developing the seigneuries and to protect all  
colonists from aggressions of the natives and the English.

He will act as my official representative at all events held in the colony.
